

Age groups:

(4 - 5 years and 6 - 10 years)

Welcome to the Kids' Maker Space, where imagination meets creation! Here, young minds will experience the future through the exciting world of science, engineering, math, coding, and the arts (STEAM). A variety of hands-on activities will transform these children from dreamers into doers.

Math:

Spatial Reasoning:

Students will be able to build and manipulate objects to recreate simple geometric shapes (e.g., squares, triangles) using age-appropriate materials.

Engineering:

Students will be able to design a simple structure (e.g., bridge, tower) using provided materials. Students will be able to observe and record the results of their experiments and explain the relationship between cause and effect.

Coding:

Students will be able to create simple programs using a block-based coding interface to control basic actions (e.g., move forward, turn) in a virtual environment (e.g., robot simulation).

Problem-solving and Logic:

Students will be able to apply problem-solving and logical thinking skills to develop their code.

Students will be able to follow simple experiment procedures to investigate a scientific phenomenon.
